MINUTES

December 5, 1983

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the fifth day of December, 1983 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

2. Mr. Hampson moved to dispense the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting; seconded by Mr. Douglas.

3. Council recessed to committees for discussion of the agenda items.

4. Richard Brahm, Attorney for Sohio, requested council to reconsider the second amendment to Resolution CR-34-83 which was adopted on November 21.

Mr. Hampson moved that Resolution No. CR-34-83 be brought back for reconsideration of amendment number 2 and the item be placed on the agenda; seconded by Mr. Weygandt.

The council and representatives of Sohio recessed to the Clerk's office for this discussion. It was agreed basically that the service station would share the established curb cut and a portion of the drive with Bank One which would allow for ingress and egress from the drive to the service station; that a new curb cut would allow right turn only on the egress to Stringtown Road.

The discussion resumed in the council chambers and Bob Morris questioned why another service station would be allowed on Stringtown Road, the amount of curb cuts already on Stringtown Road, left turns and dangerous situations. Dan Axline, representing Sohio, and David Douglas and John Hampson answered Mr. Morris.

5. Edward A. Bischoff, Engineer, and Gene Merriman of the Wimpy Company spoke to council on Ordinance C-47-83, a plat of Parkmead Drive and Parkdale Blvd. There was a lengthy discussion about changing the plans to have Parkdale Blvd. begin directly across Stringtown Road from McDowell Road instead of a jog on Stringtown.
6. During discussion of Ordinance C-50-83 (Contract with Columbus for collection of income taxes), Mr. Douglas thanked Mr. Behlen, Director of Finance, for

negotiating this new contract with the Columbus fee set at 2.6% of the collections instead of the former 3% to 5% fee for this service.

7. Council reconvened.
8. Mr. Hampson read Resolution CR-34-83 and moved to amend amendment number 2 to indicate the development plan for ingress and egress on Stringtown Road, as presented to Council on December 5, 1983, be approved; seconded by Mr. DeWeese.
