1. The Council of the City of Grove City, Franklin County, Ohio met in regular session on the sixth day of December, 1971 at 7:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers located in the Municipal Building, 42 East Park Street, Grove City, Ohio with the following members present:

Mr. David Goodin, owner of the Lincoln Village Transit Co., spoke to Council against the COTA.
