MINUTES

December 6, 1982

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the sixth day of December, 1982 in the council chambers with the following members present:

4. Ordinance No. C-80-82 was given its second reading and public hearing. Speaking to this ordinance was R. E. Gunderman. He stated that the charge from The Columbus Prosecutor's Office has risen from \$25.00 to \$40.00 per hour. He stated that with the exception of the City of Gahanna, all other cities of comparable size in Franklin County use this service.
