

SPECIAL MEETING OF GROVE CITY VILLAGE COUNCIL

December 13, 1954

PRESENT: Weygandt, Moeckel, Arick & Farnsworth

A general discussion was conducted with representatives of Jackson Homes, Inc., concerning whether or not the Village Council should approve the plat of a subdivision submitted by that Company.

Motion was made by Farnsworth, "To reject all tendered plats, inasmuch as our present sewage and water services are inadequate, said policy of rejecting subdivision plats tendered, to continue until such time as water and sewage facilities are deemed adequate by the Council of the Village."

Weygandt	-	Yes


Mr. H. J. Krieger, President of Jackson Homes, Inc., formally submitted a plat of Jackson Homes Subdivision for approval by the Council.
