1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the 15th day of December, 1986 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

 2. Mr. Stage moved to dispense the reading of the minutes; seconded by Mr. Mountain.

 3. President Nicholson announced that the council would change its order of business at this meeting by going through the agenda and discussing all ordinances except C-85-86, the appropriations budget for 1987. After voting on all other issues, the public hearing on the 1987 fiscal year budget will be held.
 4. Council recessed to committees.
 5. Charles Pappas spoke to council relative to Ordinance No. C-80-86, Group Care Facilities. Also speaking to this ordinance was Ed Harper, Residential Director of the Franklin County Board of Mental Retardation which has made application for a special use permit for a Group Care Facility.
 6. After discussion of the other agenda items and the reading of the title of the appropriations budget (Ord. C-85-86), Mr. List announced that the council will meet in Executive Session for further discussion of the budget along with the administration.

Speaking to the budget was Charles Pappas.
 7. Larry Findley, Juvenile Officer of the Grove City Police Department, stated that he and Mr. Zocklin will make application for a \$100,000.00 Federal Grant to be used in the area of juvenile drug and alcohol prevention and rehabilitation. Detective Findley urged the Mayor to appoint a task force on juvenile justice as a criteria for this grant. Detective Findley stated that this task force has an excellent chance of being awarded the grant.
 8. Council reconvened.
 9. Resolution CR-66-86 (Building permits for Suffolk Grove Phase II) was given its reading and Mr. Cotton moved it be approved; seconded by Mr. Stage.

11. Ordinance No. C-80-86 (Group Care Facility) was given its second reading and public hearing and Mr. Cotton moved this ordinance be amended as follows:

1. In Section D. subparagraph 1, to read: Group Care Facilities are facilities licensed by the State of Ohio, which provides care services and supervision for not less than nine (9), but not more than twenty-four (24) individuals-----, and the sentence "Group Care Facility does not specifically mean fraternities or sororities, boarding houses, rooming houses, group homes or group care facilities of less than nine (9) unrelated persons."
2. In Section D. subparagraph 2. to delete subsection e.
3. In Section D, subparagraph 3. to add the words "and to protect the health, safety and welfare of this community."
4. In Section D, subparagraph 4, section b in part to read: -----The facility shall provide an approved emergency alert system with a dedicated telephone line monitored by an independent agency. No group care facility shall be occupied until a certificate of occupancy has been issued by the city. Said facility shall be subject to inspection as provided by Section 1511.09 of the Grove City Codified Ordinances entitled "Fire Inspection; Right of Entry."
5. In Section D, subparagraph 4, section d in part to read:----written notice of such public hearing shall be mailed by the clerk of the legislative authority by certified-return receipt requested mail at least thirty (30) days before the date of the public hearing-----

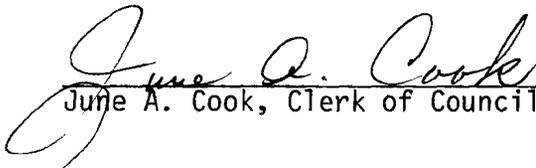

20. Major Stoll of the G.C. Police Department announced that the new offices of of the Police Department are in operation now and invited the council to view the offices.
21. Mr. List stated that all members of council endorse their gratitude to the Group Home Committee for their time, energy and deliberations. He offered the council's sincere thank you.
22. Mr. Stage moved the following resolution:

Be it resolved the Council of the City of Grove City does hereby endorse and support the formation of the Juvenile Task Force. The motion was seconded by Mr. Nicholson. Motion carried.
23. Council recessed to Executive Session at 9:10 p.m.
24. The council and Mr. Boso, Mr. Behlen and Mayor Evans discussed the operating budget and the capital improvements budget for the fiscal year 1987.
25. Council reconvened at 11:30 p.m. and it was moved an seconded to adjourn. Motion carried.
26. Mr. List announced a special meeting of council for Thursday, December 18 at 7:00 p.m. for action on the 1987 Appropriations ordinance.
