1) Would it be possible to borrow the \$750,000 now for the trunk line and put it in the bank and draw interest on it on the same basis as the \$900,000 that was borrowed a few years ago. There was \$20,000 made during the year that \$900,000 was in the bank.

2) What profit was realized from the operation of the sewage plant in 1968?

A. Mr. Edwards will advise.

3) What is the possibility of elaborating on the conditional uses and applied to industrial zoning?

A. Mr. Ozmun stated an ordinance could be drawn and he would have it ready shortly.

4) What council action is necessary on the extension of the Master Plan?

A. Mr. Ozmun advised that if council wishes, an ordinance can be prepared and submitted. If Council didn't wish to do anything and administration doesn't wish to do anything, lack of action means nothing will be done.
