On salaries, Mr. List stated: In lieu of the proposed 8 percent increase for specified employees not covered by the police contract, I move to amend the administration's proposed budget, Ordinance No. C-67-84, whereby these specified employees will receive a 5 percent base salary increase or 50 cents per hour, which ever is greater and request the administration to revise the budget accordingly. This motion is not to affect the proposed salary increase for the Secretary-Receptionist position with the Department of Administration nor positions for which no salary increases are proposed.
