December 18, 1978

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the 18th day of December, 1978 at 8:00 P.M. in the council chambers with the following members present:

After discussion of the agenda, Mr. McDonald made the comment that in the seven years he has been on the council, he would like it noted that the Administration and Council has not found it necessary to ask for a raise in property taxes or income taxes; that the city has lived within its budget and is a good example and he doesn't see why other taxing districts cannot do likewise.

7. Mr. Walter read a letter from Stephen J. Bolling, Executive Director of the Columbus Metropolitan Housing Authority inviting the council, administration and interested residents to tour any of their complexes. After a lengthy discussion, it was agreed that Mr. Evans would invite Mr. Bollinger to the January 15 meeting for discussion of senior citizen housing and the Columbus Metropolitan Housing Authority.




