Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the twentieth day of December, 1976 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

3. The Clerk informed Council of a letter from the Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. informing her that the rates for service would increase nineteen and twenty-seven hundredths cents per one thousand cubic feet effective on January 7, 1977.
4. Council recessed to committees.
5. Hugh Black and Harold Brewer representing the Police Division spoke to council and asked that the Ord. C-105-76 be amended to include more provisions that are already included in Chapter 159 of the Code of Ordinances.
- Mr. McDonald asked that they put in writing exactly what they want included and that the letter be presented to Mrs. Cook so that amendments could be made.
6. Michael Hardesty, representing the Independence Subdivision (Ord. C-106-76), requested that council waive the thirty day waiting period so that the plat could be recorded as soon as possible.
7. Ordinance No. C-93-76 (N/S corridor), put on the table on December 6, was discussed in length and Mr. Kingsmore moved that Ord. C-93-76 be removed from the table and put on the floor for action. This motion died for lack of a second.
8. Council gave their approval for a D-5 Liquor Permit for Grove City Restaurant & Lounge at 3711 Broadway.
9. Allen Keil spoke to council and inquired as to the reason that Resolution No. CR-42-76 was removed from the agenda.
- Mayor Brandt issued his statement to council about Resolution CR-42-76 and asked that Council support him in this matter.
- The resolution asked that Council support the Mayor in the need for a health care center and that it would give its consent to the Mayor for further efforts to develop plans and programs for a Health Care Facility in conjunction with Grant Hospital.
- Mr. McDonald asked that council request the Mid-Ohio Health Planning Federation to do a study as to the needs of a health facility in Grove City and to give its recommendations as to the best type of facility for these needs; that the City work with the Mid-Ohio Health Planning Federation toward the best possible facility.
10. Council reconvened; called to order by President McDonald.
11. Ordinance No. C-104-76 (transfer of monies within accounts) was given its first reading.


