


DON'T TEMPT A THIEF

Thefts from vehicles are among the most recurring crimes we face. That is unfortunate because it's a crime which can be easily prevented with little effort.



The Grove City Division of Police urges you to remove all visible items of value (such as GPS systems, PDAs, cell phones, purses, wallets, shopping bags, electronics, etc.) from your vehicle and make sure your vehicle is locked. By not 'tempting a thief' we hope to reduce theft from cars, keeping you and your valuables safe.

If you must hide items of value in the trunk, try to do so before you reach your destination. If a thief sees you place your purse in the trunk, getting it is as simple as busting a window and pushing the trunk release button. It's best to leave your purse at home if you don't want to tote it around with you.



If your vehicle's stereo has a removable faceplate, remove it when you leave your car. A stereo without a faceplate is worthless to a thief. Also, if you have any expensive equipment, such as a GPS system or satellite radio, etc. and they are removable, remove and hide them before leaving your vehicle.




Never leave your keys in your car, even if you will only be gone a few moments. If a thief steals your vehicle with your keys in it, they also have the keys to your home and whatever else is on your key ring. Please watch out for yourself and your loved ones and always lock your vehicle.

IF YOUR CAR GETS BROKEN INTO...



1. **DON'T TOUCH ANYTHING.** If you already entered your vehicle, and then realized it had been broken into, try not to disturb anything and proceed to step 2.
2. **CALL THE POLICE** at (614) 277-1710 if the break-in occurred in Grove City.
3. **GET THE SERIAL NUMBERS** of the stolen items (copy and store serial numbers after purchase) if possible, the stolen items' value, along with any insurance information to give to the officer when they arrive.
