The Ohio Flags of Honor features more than 400 full-size flags honoring Ohio soldiers who gave their lives in service to our country in Afghanistan, Iraq and around the world, and raising awareness of active and veteran military and their families. Each of Ohio's fallen soldiers has a flag labeled in his or her honor posted at the events.

Ohio Flags of Honor is a traveling exhibit organized by Gino and Lisa Zimmer whose son, Specialist Nicholaus E. Zimmer, U.S. Army, was lost in action in Iraq in 2004. The display is an extension of the Ohio Flags of Honor Foundation, a non-partisan, non-political 501(c)-3 corporation.
