AWARDS AND RECOGNITION CEREMONY

 The Grove City Easel Award and the 13th Annual Helena McComb Award will be presented on the heartland stage at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 18. Recognition for all 1st Place winners, Best of Show winners and People's Choice winners will also be presented for the Craft Show, Fine Arts Show, Photography, Quilt Show and Youth Art and City's Easel Award.

13th Annual \$500.00 Helena McComb Award

The McComb Family is proud to again sponsor an award in loving memory of one of the festival co-founders, Helena McComb. Helena's love of flowers provided the perfect subject matter for this award. This award is in addition to any of the other awards offered in all shows. One entry that features flowers will be nominated from each of the five shows and a \$500 award will be presented to the final winner.

GROVE CITY EASEL AWARD

One artist in this category will be awarded a \$2000 purchase prize in the Grove City Easel Award contest, a highlight of the annual Arts in the Alley celebration. Entry Fee: \$15.00 per entry (limit of two), payable by cash or check to: Grove City Area Chamber of Commerce. Each entry shall have its own registration, claim check and number.

The People's Choice in this category will be awarded \$500. The piece may be of any media and of all surfaces including, but not limited to relief, fabric, wood, glass, etc., as well as 2D paintings, drawings, etc., but must depict Grove City's past, present and/or future. All entries must be hangable. 3-D art is no longer eligible for the Grove City Easel Award. The content may contain some aspect of a previous Award, but the depiction must be a fresh approach.

Easel Award entrants must register specifically for the Grove City Easel Award and may do so in City Council Chambers in City Hall, 4035 Broadway, Grove City, Ohio on Wednesday, September 14 or Thursday, September 15 between 5:00 pm and 8:00 pm. The winning entry is selected by a panel of judges. No one affiliated with the City is on the panel.
