Public Sculpture Competition

The City of Grove City and Grove City Arts Council are sponsoring a public sculpture competition to further the Art in the Park program. If the winning entry is commissioned, the art will be installed at Breck Community Park, 3005 Demorest Road, Grove City, Ohio.

ELIGIBILITY

The contest is open to all artists/sculptors who are at least 18 years of age and reside in Ohio. Employees of the City of Grove City and their immediate families are not eligible to participate.

THEME

The contest theme is Eco Art.

SUBMISSIONS

Entries may be submitted in the following forms:

- Actual three dimensional figurine or;
- If entries are made in either of the following, at least four images are required showing all sides of the sculpture;
 - 1) CD in PDF format of photos or drawings
 - 2) Actual drawings no larger than 8.5 x 11 inches

Entries should be submitted by U.S. mail no later than August 1, 2016 to Eco Art, 3378 Park Street, Suite E, Grove City, Ohio 43123 OR by email to: creative64@rocketmail.com, OR call Dennise Hunt at (614) 670-2926 to make arrangements to drop off entries in person by 1:30 p.m. August 1, 2016. All entries must be labeled with artist's signature and contact information. Entries will be available for pick-up after August 31, 2016.

Entries must include:

1. Fully completed and signed application,
2. A brief description of the inspiration behind the work and how it relates to Breck Community Park,
3. Dimensions planned for each element of the actual sculpture (e.g. separate measurements for a pedestal for the statue),
4. Materials to be used in construction, and
5. Any special notes regarding construction, footing requirements, method of installation and display,
6. Cost estimate to construct and install sculpture, not to exceed \$25,000.

SPECIFICATIONS

The work must be:

- Made of eco-friendly or recycled materials to withstand Ohio weather conditions;
- Of the highest quality construction;
- Considerate of safety: lack of sharp edges etc.;
- Original art created by the artist;
- Structurally sound unsupervised public audience;
- Guaranteed against defects and deterioration;
- Fitting for a park setting. The finished sculpture should not exceed 6 feet in height and 6 feet in width/length.

JUDGING

Judging will be conducted by a five panel committee. The top three entries will be placed on public display at the Grove City EcoFest, August 20, 2016 where public votes will be solicited. A final winner will be chosen by August 31, 2016.

WINNING SELECTION

The winner will be notified promptly and receive \$1,000. Second place winner will receive \$500. A decision to proceed with commissioning the sculpture will be made by a separate committee.

I further agree that any resolutions to any disputes that arise regarding the contest, construction and installation process will be decided by a mutually agreed upon independent arbiter, and I will abide by its decision as final. Ohio law shall govern.
