# CYBER BLOCKWATCH

By joining a BlockWatch Program, you are taking an important step to work cooperatively with the Grove City Division of Police to safeguard your family, home, and neighborhood.

Our goal is to offer a program that will provide Grove City residents easy access to important crime prevention information on a regular basis. Such information may include home security, personal safety, area crime trends and more.



First, complete the accompanying application and sign the consent. This information, which includes your name, home address, email address, and phone number, will enable us to provide you with important crime prevention information as soon as it becomes available. All personal information you provide is kept strictly confidential and is only used for our notifications.

If you are applying to represent yourself as a neighborhood captain, please include an estimated number of individuals you are forwarding this information to (they do not have to live in your neighborhood). You may also sign up to receive the information for yourself if you are not part of a group.



Cyber BlockWatch Newsletters are sent out via email on a quarterly basis. Information regarding crime trends in your area is also sent out on a timely basis to help you protect yourself and your property.

## Where does Cyber BlockWatch information come from?

Cyber Blockwatch information comes from a variety of sources.

Sometimes information is gathered through police investigations. Information is passed along regarding suspects or crime trends which may affect you.

Probably one of the easiest ways for the police to receive information on possible crimes is for you, your family and neighbors to alert the police of any suspicious activity witnessed.

By working cooperatively with the police department, you can help reduce the possibility of falling victim to a crime.
