How to Prepare Your Children to Call 9-1-1

1. Talk about it! Explain what constitutes an emergency and when they should call 9-1-1.
2. Teach your children their address and phone number. When you are out, ask your children if they know where they are and talk about why you are asking.
3. Unplug a land line phone and have them practice dialing 9-1-1. Do not use a cell phone to practice, even old cell phones will call 9-1-1 if there is a battery attached.
4. Tell them what to expect. Dispatchers will ask a series of questions to determine the response needed, officers or fire/EMS. It is important they stay on the line until they are told to disconnect.
5. Explain they should NEVER be afraid to call 9-1-1 in an emergency situation.

Let Us Help Your Family Be Prepared

You never know when an emergency may affect your family. The Grove City Division of Police provides a program for preschool and elementary school age children to teach them about 9-1-1. Our goal is to help prepare children for an emergency by providing them with a degree of control. Let us help your family learn about 9-1-1 safety with fun, age-appropriate activities presented by the people on the other end of the phone when they call.

How do I get my child or group signed up?

The program is held in a classroom setting at the Division of Police. We also go mobile and visit classrooms and youth groups!

Programs held at the Division of Police include a tour of the 9-1-1 Dispatch Center. We ask that groups not exceed 25 students.

2. What constitutes an emergency?
3. Examples of when and when not to call 9-1-1.
4. What happens after calling 9-1-1?
5. Ramifications of prank calling 9-1-1.
