## Anonymous Tipline

**614-277-1808**

The Grove City Division of Police provides an Anonymous Tipline to report suspicious activity. The Tipline is an automated message system checked regularly and is not intended for calls that need immediate assistance. The Division of Police will investigate all tips.

### Who SHOULD use the Anonymous Tipline?

Anyone can use the Tipline. Always use 9-1-1 for emergencies or crimes-in-progress.

### The Tipline may be useful if:

- You suspect any criminal activity.
- You have witnessed illegal drug activity, prostitution, gang activity, child abuse or anything that doesn't "look right."

### Who SHOULD NOT use the Anonymous Tipline?

- Anyone who needs immediate help from the police. Call 614-277-1710.
- Anyone who is reporting crimes in progress or emergency situations. Call 9-1-1.

## Suspicious Activity

While many situations have innocent and legal explanations, the Division of Police wants to receive a call to investigate all situations considered suspicious. Call the police immediately if you witness suspicious activity such as:

- Someone loitering around cars or peering into multiple cars
- Slow-moving vehicles driving aimlessly or circling
- Apparent business transactions conducted from a vehicle
- Someone forced into a vehicle
- Abandoned vehicle
- Someone with a weapon
- Someone loitering, entering or leaving a business before or after hours
- Alarms sounding or glass breaking

**Remember that timely reporting is important! Dial 9-1-1 for emergency situations or 614-277-1710 for non-emergency reporting right away.**
