Bicycle Safety/Bicycle Registration

In cooperation with Nationwide Children's Hospital, officers reward safe bicycle practices with a coupon for ice cream when they observe children wearing helmets or making correct hand signals. The Grove City Division of Police registers bicycles and provides bicycle licenses free of charge at the Safety Complex.

D.A.R.E.

Drug Abuse Resistance Education is a program presented by a specially trained officer for elementary and middle school students regarding a variety of topics including: how to say NO to drugs, self-esteem, violence, decision making, gangs and more.

Senior Safety

Program participants receive information specific to senior citizens regarding: how to prevent becoming a target of crime, how to protect your money and how to prevent being conned.

Our Goal

The Grove City Division of Police is committed to partnering with the community to develop successful community-based programs. This unique partnership resulted in several effective community-centered programs.

Child Identification Program

Parents provide the Grove City Division of Police with their child's photo and descriptive information. A photo I.D. is prepared for the parents to present in the event of a missing or runaway child.

Community Watch Volunteer Program

Community Watch is an organized group of volunteers from the Citizens Police Academy trained to assist the Grove City Division of Police with safety awareness and special event support.

Walk & Talk

Officers, when possible will stop and interact with the community.

Crime Alert

Program participants are immediately alerted to current crime and safety information through email and social media.

Preventive Patrol Reports

Officers provide resident notices when they observe a situation that may pose a threat to citizen safety or property.

Security Check

When you plan to leave your home or business unattended, the Grove City Division of Police will provide security checks, as time permits, while you are away. Sign up online before you leave.
