WHEREAS: on April 18, 1917 the Grove City Community Club was formed by Mrs. Ethel Grossman and Mrs. Irene Hensel to serve the needs of the community with Mrs. Grossman elected as its first president; and

WHEREAS: the Grove City Community Club is a proud property owner in the Historic Town Center of Grove City, having purchased and improved the clubhouse located at 3397 Civic Place; and


WHEREAS: the Grove City Community Club members have continued to give generously of their time and talents. During WWII, the Community Club helped with War Bonds and blood donations. Today, their donations include Grove City Emergency Services, Southwest Franklin County Historical Society, educational scholarships and the interactive scoreboard for Buddy Ball at the Dreamfield; and

WHEREAS: the Grove City Community Club hosts several fundraisers to aid their donation efforts, including their famous chicken and noodle dinners during Arts in the Alley and on Election Day. Other events include hosting the Harvest Market and annual tree festival. All of which help the Community Club provide needed resources to the community.
