Whereas: Ervin E. Hritz was born November 25, 1917 and;

Whereas: Ervin E. Hritz was inducted into the United States Army on July 31, 1941 at Fort Hayes. Columbus, Ohio, and was assigned to the 34th Infantry Division, 168th Regiment Company A, and;

Whereas: Ervin E. Hritz was deployed to Scotland for training and later to Tunisla where he and the 34th Division were engaged at Kasserine Pass, Sheitla, Fondonk, and was wounded at Oran, Algeria, and;

Whereas: Ervin E. Hritz and the 34th Division were further deployed on September 21. 1943 to Italy engaging in battle at Salerno and later Ervin E. Hritz was taken as a POW by the German Army, and;

Whereas: Ervin E. Hritz spent 17 months as a POW at Stalag 3B being liberated in April, 1945 by US Forces and later in September, 1945 was mustered out of the United States Army at Camp Atterbury, Indiana, and;


Whereas: Ervin E. Hritz was awarded numerous medals and honors, including: Eastern Theater Ribbon with three Bronze Stars; a Purple Heart with one Oak Leaf Ciuster; Prisoner of War Medal; Good Conduct Medal and the American Service Medal, and;

Whereas: ErvinE. Hritz established his home and family in Grove City. Ohlo in 1955 and passing in Grove City in 1976;
