- Schedules and rules will be distributed at this time. Fees must be paid in full by this time.

League Information:

- Fee is \$290 per team and must be paid in full by the Managers' Meeting.
- Make checks payable to: **The City of Grove City**
- Returning teams receive priority for league placement; full league payment is due at the time of application. New teams are added to leagues as space permits based on when the application is submitted; full league payment is due at the Managers' Meeting. Sponsored teams are responsible for arranging financial backing with their sponsor; the league payment due date will not be delayed.
- New teams will receive notification regarding acceptance into the league of their choice by Monday, Aug. 3.
- Completed roster forms are due to the Parks and Rec. office by 4:30 p.m. the day of the team's first game.
- Games are played at Fryer Park, 3899 Orders Road, as daylight permits. Leagues playing Monday through Friday evenings will move to Windsor Park to play on lighted fields once necessary.
- All players agree to abide by the posted league rules, including, but not limited to:
 - Consumption of or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol, reckless driving, parking cars out of designated areas, littering and/or conduct deemed inappropriate by the sports supervisor are prohibited on park grounds.
 - Unsportsmanlike conduct is not tolerated before, during or after a game, and will result in ejection from the contest and/or indefinite suspension. Any ejected player must leave the park immediately.
 - Violations may result up to an immediate forfeit for the team, a two-week suspension of the team manager, and indefinite suspension of the individual who committed the violation.
- Players must adhere to any restrictions put in place to limit the spread of COVID-19.
- **Please note the following restrictive rules:**
 - **Home Run Limits:** There is a maximum of four home runs permitted on men's and women's rec and co-rec teams. Five home runs are allowed for competitive leagues. Additional home runs are deemed **dead-ball outs**.
 - **Pitching Arc:** The USSSA 3-to-10-foot arc pitching rule is enforced for rec/comp leagues.

The Sports Weather Line is 614-277-3060; press 4 then 2.
The line is updated by 4 p.m. on inclement weather days.

Decisions are based on field conditions at the time as forecasts can be unreliable.
 Be sure to recheck the line before leaving for your game if the weather becomes threatening.
 The final decision on playing is at the discretion of the umpire.
