
Methodology

- A digital questionnaire was emailed to 3,279 Grove City residents on Tuesday, May 8, 2018.
- Reminder emails were deployed on Friday, May 11; Friday, May 18; and Wednesday, May 23.
- By the May 24 deadline, 737 Grove City residents had returned a completed questionnaire, yielding a response rate of 22%.
- The margin of error for this survey is ± 3.6 percentage points at the 95 percent level of confidence.
- The data were weighted to better reflect known population parameters.

Findings



- 82% Men
- 85% Women
- 88% Younger than 35
- 79% 35 to 54
- 86% 55 or older
- 84% Resident for < 5 yrs.
- 81% Resident for 5 to 10 yrs.
- 84% Resident for > 10 yrs.
- 83% Owners
- 86% Renters

Findings *(continued)*

“What would you suggest or recommend to improve the Grove City Police Department?”

22% Offered at least one suggestion or recommendation

4% Be more involved in community events and activities

4% Be more visible in neighborhoods

3% Add more officers, including K-9s

3% Enforce traffic laws

10% Other suggestions and recommendations (each < 3%)

13% Offered a compliment

66% Offered no comment
