



# **VOLUNTEER COACH DISQUALIFICATIONS**

Any adult serving in the capacity of head or assistant coach or who is otherwise on the field/court during games or practices must submit a coach's application and pass a background check. At any time, the Grove City Parks and Recreation reserves the right to not consider an applicant who has had any criminal conviction deemed to be of such nature as to cause damage to the effectiveness of the City of Grove City.

The lengths of disqualification for eliminating offenses includes the following:

## **Permanent**

Conviction of any sexual crime; felony conviction for drugs or violence

## **10 years**

Any felony offense other than related to violence, sex or drugs; multiple misdemeanor drug and alcohol offenses

## **7 years**

All misdemeanor violent offenses

## **5 years**

Any misdemeanor offense related to drugs, alcohol (including OVI) or potential danger to children

## **Disqualifying offenses include, but are not limited to, the following:**

### **Drugs/Alcohol**

- Operating a motor vehicle while impaired
- Drunk and disorderly conduct, public intoxication
- Drug possession or other offenses that are not minor misdemeanors or drug possession offenses
- Illegal manufacture of drugs or cultivation of marijuana
- Corrupting another with drugs
- Trafficking in drugs, funding of drug or marijuana trafficking
- Illegal administration or distribution of anabolic steroids
- Providing alcohol to a minor
- Placing harmful objects in or adulterating food or confection

### **Violence/Sexual Offenses/Theft**

- Carrying concealed weapons, having weapons while under disability, improperly discharging firearm at or into a habitation or school
- Aggravated murder, murder, voluntary manslaughter, involuntary manslaughter
- Aggravated robbery, robbery
- Felonious assault, aggravated assault, assault
- Rape, sexual battery, sexual assault, gross sexual imposition, voyeurism, public indecency, sodomy, felonious sexual penetration
- Aggravated menacing
- Compelling, promoting or procuring prostitution; importuning, solicitation, pandering obscenity
- Domestic violence
- Kidnapping, abduction, child stealing, criminal child enticement
- Disseminating matter harmful to juveniles, pandering obscenity involving a minor, pandering sexually oriented matter involving a minor, illegal use of a minor in nudity-oriented material or performance

### **Theft/Corruption/Neglect**

- Aggravated burglary, burglary
- Theft, embezzlement, fraud
- Corruption of a minor, contributing to the delinquency of a child
- Endangering children
- Failing to provide for a functionally impaired person
- Patient abuse or neglect
