Skilled Trades Labor Award Application

The City of Grove City, in an effort to encourage those seeking a Skilled Trade Certificate to remain residents and contributors to the City, has established an award program. The following conditions apply:

TRADE STUDENT:

1. Residency in the City of Grove City Ohio's corporation limits.
2. Acceptance in a Trade School and/or Apprentice Program that:
 - a. Is accredited by the National Council for Independent Colleges and Schools; or
 - b. Offers a Certificate and Licensure track program recognized by State of Ohio Apprenticeship Council; and
 - c. Approved by the Grove City Higher Education Investment Committee.
3. Applicant must completion of ten (10) volunteer service hours every cycle/semester/term to the City of Grove City through the "Keep Grove City Beautiful" program; the "VIP" program; Gardens at Gantz Volunteers; Citizens Police Academy; or other volunteer hours within the City as may be approved by the Higher Education Investment Committee.
4. Submit proof of passage for each cycle/semester/term to the Clerk of Council.
5. Scholarship application must be completed each cycle/semester/term.
6. Awards will be \$700.00 per cycle/semester/term, up to a maximum of \$2,100.00 total. Funding for the Higher Education Investment Program is contingent upon City Council approval.
