RecSchool is a preschool program operated by the Grove City Parks and Recreation Department. The RecSchool staff is committed to nurturing socialization, learning and creativity in a group setting. Classrooms are set up to offer opportunities that enhance academic, social, creative, physical and emotional development. Teachers are committed to fostering children’s connection to the natural environment by planning frequent nature adventures in Gantz Park. Planned activities, both outdoors and in the classroom, are aligned with the Ohio Department of Education’s Early Learning and Development Standards to assure a well-rounded learning experience. Early academics are incorporated into all experiences, allowing children to see the importance of reading, writing, math and science in daily life.

We respect each child as a unique learner and encourage children to seek out activities and projects that are meaningful to his/her developmental needs and individual interests. Teachers work with children to develop child-driven ideas, problem-solve social and personal conflicts and foster their natural love of learning. Children develop a positive self-image through respect, acceptance and successful experiences.

RecSchool staff members recognize parents as the primary, most influential teachers in each child’s life. Staff and parents share insights, observations and concerns. Working as partners, staff and parents can provide consistent, loving care that nurtures the development of the whole child.
