



# Grove City Community Garden FAQs (2022)

## Where is the Grove City Community Garden located?

The garden is located in Fryer Park, 3899 Orders Road, just north of the small parking lot east of Discover Drive as you enter the park.

## What hours are the Community Gardens open?

The gardens are open daily from dawn to dusk.

## Who can register for a plot?

Applicants must be age 18 or older and a resident of Grove City. You must have an online account to register.

## How do I register for a plot?

All registration for garden plots is online at [registration.grovecityohio.gov](http://registration.grovecityohio.gov).

An online account and password must be secured before registering online. If you have not previously registered with the Parks and Recreation Department, call 614-277-3050 weekdays, 8 a.m.-5 p.m., to set up an account. Upon registration, you will receive an annual garden agreement and liability waiver by email. Return completed forms by the date specified. After the agreement is received, a plot will be assigned.

## What does registration begin for the Community Garden?

The registration deadline is Friday, April 1 or until all plots are reserved.

## What is the deadline to register for a Community Garden plot?

Registration opens for new gardeners Monday, Feb. 7.

## What sizes are the Community Garden plots?

The gardens consist of raised garden plots either 4' x 10' or 4' x 12'. The plots are available on a first-come, first-served basis. A small number of elevated beds for physically challenged individuals are available by special request.

## What is the cost to rent a Community Garden plot?

The rental fee is based on plot size and covers the entire growing season.

- 4' x 10' plot is \$20
- 4' x 12' plot is \$30
- Elevated garden plot is \$30

## How are the Community Garden plots assigned?

Once you register for a plot, a bed of the size you requested is assigned to you randomly. You will be notified via email of your plot number. All gardeners are expected to adhere to the Community Garden Rules.

## When will the Community Garden plots be available to start gardening?

The gardens are scheduled to be available to gardeners starting Saturday, May 7. All registered garden users will be contacted with any date changes.
